- Sebastian Medical Fund: for the treatment homeless animals, in the County's three animal shelters
- We will continue to support the SMAC clinic which performs the Spay and Neuter of the majority of animals throughout the Santa Barbara County shelter system.
- Our Disaster Fund has paid for medical treatment of the Tea Fire's littlest victims.
- We value increased awareness and education for our community, and will be offering a variety of pilot programs

- As a partner in our community, we will have funding in place to assist with low cost spay and neuter, as well as, our continued support of Feral Spay Days to do our part to reduce pet overpopulation.
